INSTRUMENTAL MUSIC PROGRAM AT ST ANDREW'S CATHOLIC PRIMARY SCHOOL NEW ENROLMENT / RE ENROLMENT

Tuition is offered for a variety of instruments and are offered to children throughout the primary school. Different instruments have different recommended ages of commencement requirements and hence starting to learn a musical instrument is in consultation with the school's music teacher, Mrs Mulholland. All children learning an instrument must have an instrument of their own to practise on. The cost of lessons will vary depending upon whether the lesson is individual or a group and the length of time allocated.

2017 current costs are:

- \$30 – 30 minute individual lesson
- \$15 - 30 minute group lesson

Families should commit to an initial tuition for a six month period. A term's notice **in writing** must be given to the tutor if the child is withdrawing from the program. Tuition costs are paid directly to the tutor, who will invoice families. Music tuition must be paid in advance, prior to lessons commencing. If tuition fees fall into arrears, without consultation with the tutor, lessons will be suspended immediately.

Families, who wish their child to be involved in music tuition at the school, **must also be current in their school fees**. Under no circumstances will children be able to participate in the program if their family are not up to date with their school fees.

Lessons are conducted on a rotating timetable, during school time which means that unless it is unavoidable, children will not miss the same subject each week. Small groups of children working with one tutor does not always allow this to happen, however, this is the goal. Parents are not able to select the lesson times as this will be coordinated directly with Mrs Mulholland and the Instrument tutor.

Lessons which are missed by the tutor will be made up at the earliest possible time. Lessons missed by the child will be forfeited and the tutor will NOT be expected to make up missed lessons.

If you are interested in the program, please completed and return the slip below and return it to **Mrs Mulholland directly**. Completing the slip does **NOT** commit you to lessons nor does it guarantee acceptance into the program. (Lesson spaces may already be full from pervious students participating in lessons.)

It is important for families to realise that the children learning the instrument must have a strong desire to do so, or there will be little success forthcoming.
